Our office recently received your voter registration application. Pursuant to §17-3-54 of the Code of Alabama (1975), your registration was rejected due to the registration form being incomplete.

In order to be a registered voter in Alabama, applicants must provide either their **Alabama** driver's license number (or non-driver's ID number), the last four digits of their social security number, or a written explanation of why neither of those numbers can be provided.

Your registration form either did not have one of the required numbers listed or the number(s) you did provide could not be verified.

In order to complete your registration, please complete the included voter registration form and return it to our office. If you have been issued either an Alabama driver's license (or non-driver's ID) or a social security number, you **must** provide that on the registration form. If you have never been issued an Alabama driver's license (or non-driver's ID) or a social security number, then complete the included affidavit **AND** the voter registration form and then return both documents to our office.
